Responsibilities

The monitoring, evaluation and learning officer will be responsible for the design, coordination and implementation of the monitoring and evaluation, research and learning framework of the projects. He/she will develop systematic monitoring framework to improve qualitative and quantitative evidence gathered by the projects. She/he will also provide technical assistance to implementers, particularly in relation to monitoring, reporting and governance issues. Lastly, she/he will contribute to the development of proposals for possible new projects and project design.

- Minimum of Bachelor's degree in quantitative research, development statistics, project planning and management, community or international development studies, monitoring and evaluation or any other field related to impact analysis.
- At least 3 years of relevant working experience as MEL specialist for impact projects in Civil Society Organizations
- Proven expertise in data collection methodologies, in-depth knowledge of sampling and use of interviews, focus groups, and interactive tools to generate qualitative information and analysis with ability to communicate results clearly using graphs, charts and other visuals.
